

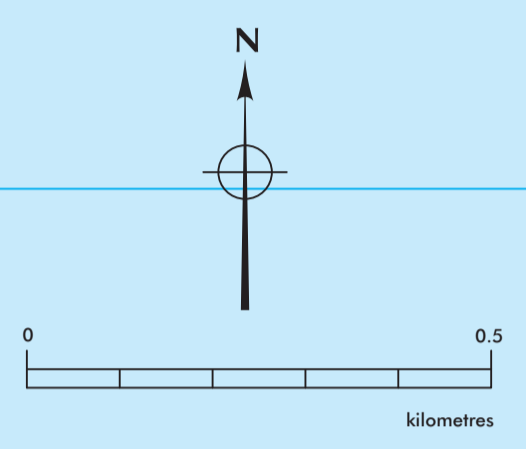


Wellington City CBD Cycling map

- On road cycling (cycle with care)
- Cycle path (sealed dual with pedestrians)
- Mountain bike track (off road)
- On road cycling lane
- Motorway - cycling prohibited
- Bus lane (A bus lane is a shared facility, primarily for buses but also for motorcyclists and cyclists. Remember the law says that neither should impede the other unnecessarily. In lanes marked 'Buses Only' motorcyclists and cyclists are prohibited.)
- Railway station cycle lockers long term
- Cycle shop
- Cycle hire
- Cycle shop/hire
- Service station
- Information centre
